

Fiscal bills over the last 2 years

This demo report illustrates the publication format. Numbers shown are placeholder values for the MVP and will be replaced by collected data once the backend pipeline is online.

Headline

Federal fiscal bills introduced rose approximately **5%** over the trailing 24 months versus the prior 24-month window. Growth concentrated in appropriations and tax-related bills; non-fiscal bills were flat to slightly down.

Composition

Within fiscal bills, appropriations and tax accounted for the majority of the growth. Reauthorizations were flat. Continuing-resolution-style measures rose modestly, consistent with the longer median time from introduction to vote noted in prior reports.

Caveats

Counts include re-introductions across sessions. State-level activity is excluded from this federal-only view. Stage-reached breakdowns (introduced, reported, passed, signed) are published separately in companion reports.

Method note

Source

Bills are collected from public legislative trackers. Each bill is tagged by topic (fiscal vs non-fiscal, plus narrower subtype), sponsor party, and stage reached.

Windows

The trailing 24-month window ends at the publish date of this report. The prior window is the matching 24-month window immediately before it. No seasonal adjustment is applied.

Reproducibility

Each report is published as a fixed PDF. Updated numbers ship as new reports rather than in-place edits, so the figures cited above remain stable.
